#### **Candidate Requirements**

- 1.) **EXPERIENCE:** Have a <u>minimum of three years</u> and <u>no more than eight years</u> of documented industrial and/or office real estate brokerage experience and is actively engaged as an industrial and/or office real estate broker or salesperson.
- 2.) **PRODUCTION:** Demonstrate minimum production in one year as measured by Gross Fee Income (GFI) within the standards set by the local chapters. GFI is the fee income directly attributable to the applicant that the applicant's firm receives before splits. The applicant must meet 50% of the set GFI amount for the 12 months preceding the application. - 3.) **ENDORSEMENT:** Submit a formal endorsement from an Active Individual Member in the applicant's chapter who is outside the applicant's firm.
- 4.) **MENTOR:** Obtain a mentor, an Active Individual Member in the applicant's chapter. The mentor is responsible for providing guidance and advice while the Candidate is working towards earning the SIOR designation.
- 5.) **ETHICS:** Uphold high ethical standards of practice and pledge to uphold SIOR's *Code of Ethical Principles and Standards of Professional Practice* by completing SIOR's online ethics course.
